HUGHES APPOINTED TO MIDWEST-CANADA RELATIONS COMMITTEE

COLUMBUS— State Senator Jim Hughes (R- Columbus) announced today he has been appointed to the Midwestern Legislative Conference (MLC) Midwest-Canada Relations Committee, a bipartisan panel of lawmakers from 11 Midwestern states and four Canadian provinces tasked with examining policy issues such as trade and border security between the region and Canada.

“Canada is an important partner to Ohio and its neighbors in the region,” Hughes said. “I look forward to working with my fellow committee members on how we can improve this relationship, creating new job opportunities and strengthening our economy both here in the U.S. and in Canada.”

Additionally, Hughes has also been named to the MLC’s Economic Development Committee and Energy Committee.

The MLC is supported by the Council for State Governments (CSG), and includes lawmakers from Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota and Wisconsin. The Canadian provinces of Alberta, Manitoba, Ontario and Saskatchewan are affiliate members of the MLC.
