Columbus – Senator Tim Schaffer (R-Lancaster) today announced the availability of 260 scholarships worth more than \$1,000,000 to attend one of Ohio's career colleges or schools. Available scholarships may be one-half tuition or specific amount programs.

These scholarships are provided by the Ohio Association of Career Colleges and Schools through cooperation with members of the Ohio General Assembly and 39 participating career colleges and schools.

“These scholarships are a great opportunity for 2011 graduates to attend a career school for little or no cost. These programs will prepare individuals with the education and training they need to begin a career in an Ohio business or industry,” Schaffer said.
