TIM SCHAFFER SWORN IN FOR SECOND TERM IN OHIO SENATE

COLUMBUS — As part of the opening day ceremonies for the 129th General Assembly, State Senator Tim Schaffer (R- Lancaster) was officially sworn in today for his second term as a member of the Ohio Senate. Schaffer represents the 31st Ohio Senate District, which encompasses Fairfield, Hocking, Licking and Perry counties and eastern portions of Pickaway County.

“I am humbled and grateful to continue to have the privilege of representing the people of the 31st Senate District in the Ohio Legislature,” Schaffer said. “Throughout my second term, I pledge to continue my efforts to encourage economic development and job creation in our communities, fight government corruption and ensure the safety of Ohio’s children and families.”

Senator Schaffer was first elected to the Ohio Senate in 2006 after serving six years as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives.
